### **Labyrinth** - What is a labyrinth?

The labyrinth is an ancient sacred symbol of pilgrimage to the Divine. Early Christians took a vow to visit the Holy City of Jerusalem at some point in their lives, but during the Middle ages, travel was unsafe, and other means were needed to fulfill the sacred commitments. Labyrinths were adopted by the Roman Church to offer a way of fulfilling the sacred pilgrimage.

Unlike a maze the labyrinth has only one path which leads to the center and out again. There are no tricks, dead ends, cul-de-sacs, or intersecting paths. There are no choices to be made, other than the primary one: the decision to enter the path. The path winds throughout and becomes a mirror for where we are in our lives. Walking the path is letting go of daily concerns and opening ourselves to God's healing presence in the center. The insights we receive are then taken back out the path into our lives.
